



He is the Pro Vice-Chancellor and Professor at ALM College of Higher Education, Dundee, Scotland, and a Fellow of the Royal Society of Arts (FRSA). With over 20 years of international experience, Dr. Garad has contributed to academia and industry through senior roles in the UK, UAE, and beyond. He is also the Founding Editor-in-Chief of the International Journal of Strategy and Organisational Learning and a trustee at Lisbon Business and Government School, widely recognized for his impactful work in education and organizational development.

OPENING REMARKS

Mr. Arshad Akif, CEO of ASK Development, extended a special welcome to Dr. Alaa Garad and invited him to share his insights on the event's central theme. He talked about the contemporary approaches for learning and organizational development. Akif explained the fundamentals of concepts by SHRM, CIPD, Bersin by Deloitte, and McKinsey that promote segmented learning and compartmentalization. Dr. Alaa explained that the Learning Driven-Organization model is research-backed and addresses performance improvement, excellence, resilience, and sustainability.

Following the keynote address, participants engaged in an interactive Q&A session with Dr. Alaa. Attendees posed thought-provoking questions regarding challenges and opportunities in building learning-driven organizations, to which Dr. Alaa responded with practical insights and real-world examples.
